In this assignment, you are given a short story. You will use Auto Shapes and Clip Arts to make comics out of the given story.

TASK 1 – INSERT THE TITLE

Use Word-Art to insert a title for the comics at the top of the document: “The Fox and the Stork”.

TASK 2 – MAKE THE STORY TELLING BOXES

- Set the text color to yellow.

TASK 3 – INSERT THE CLIP-ARTS

For each frame insert Clip Art images that suits the story. You don't have to use the same Clip Arts with the sample.



TASK 4 – INSERT THE CALL-OUTS

For each frame make the conversation call-outs using AutoShapes for the conversation.



TASK 5 – FINAL

For the final frame think of a lesson that the story teaches:

- draw a banner in the final frame using AutoShapes
- add text to the banner and type your message
